'Abd al-Laṭīf al-Baġdādī's Philosophical Journey

From Aristotle's *Metaphysics* to the 'Metaphysical Science'

Although the philosopher 'Abd al-Laṭīf al-Baġdādī (1162 -1231) received an extensive education in the thought of Avicenna, he still journeyed long in search of true philosophy. It was in Cairo that he finally discovered a model of philosophical metaphysics rooted in Greek thought as set out in Kindian and Farabian writings. This volume is devoted to the study of Aristotle's *Metaphysics* and other Greek metaphysical writing gathered together by this Muslim philosopher to form a 'Metaphysical Science' in his *Book of the Science of Metaphysics* (*Kitāb fī 'ilm mā ba'd al-ṭabī'a*).
